Guidance Counsellor's Guide - Information Pack 2022

The Medical Poland Admission Office represents Polish medical universities offering MD Programmes (Undergraduate & Graduate Entry), Dentistry, Physiotherapy, Pharmacy, Nursing and Veterinary through English in Poland. There are 15 public and 1 private institutions offering those programmes.

We also represent hundreds of international students in Poland and have helped many Irish, British, Canadian, Indian and other students embark on their medical journey. As there is no central application system in Poland, the Medical Poland Admission Office guides through the application processes to individual institutions, helps access medical schools, prepares for interviews and entrance exams, supports students throughout the programmes and in starting medical careers (both in Poland and home countries). We make sure that our students receive the best quality of education, support and feel comfortable in Poland.

General Information

Poland is a country where tradition and modernity meet. Our universities use modern teaching techniques and offer high educational standards, an individual approach for every student and a great international experience of faculty members. Aside from the current improvements, we take pride in our traditional academic background. There are more than 1.1 million students studying in Poland, at almost 400 universities.

Qualifications gained through studying at Polish medical universities are recognized all over the world. State-of-the-art facilities, small groups, faculty with international experience and low living costs make Poland a great place to start a medical career. HPAT is not required. Entry requirements for specific universities vary immensely.

At the majority of Polish universities, application deadlines are between late June and late August (with exemptions). However, the admission processes are typically designed in such a way that they are slightly more competitive closer to deadlines. We strongly encourage early applications to increase chances - it is possible to secure a conditional offer from January, before sitting the Leaving Certificate - based on predicted grades (school letter and interview and/or test performance).

Medical Poland Fee (2021-22: 245 EUR) guarantees support throughout the research, admission process and the whole time of study. Medical Poland Admission Office:

Collegium Medicum (Nicolaus Copernicus University) in Bydgoszcz is the most popular Polish medical school in Ireland (160+ Irish students) which keeps exceptionally low student-lecturer ratio keeping a very high level of education quality.

- Biology and chemistry or physics at secondary school final exam (e.g. Leaving Cert/A-Levels) (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)

Nursing (Bachelor, 3-year)

- Preparatory Course – approx. 500 EUR – mandatory preparatory course for freshmen (September)

Physiotherapy (Master's degree, 5 years)

Basic admission requirements and documents:

- biology or chemistry or physics at secondary school final exam (e.g. Leaving Cert/A-Levels) (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- Online interview (general motivation and attitude, questions in biology, chemistry, physics)

Fees:

- Tuition fees: ± EUR 6 800 pa
- Application fee: 85 PLN

Pharmacy (Master's degree, 5.5 years)

Basic admission requirements and documents:

- 2 out of three science subjects (biology, chemistry, physics) at secondary school final exam (e.g. Leaving Cert/A-Levels) (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- Online interview (general motivation and attitude, questions in biology, chemistry, physics)

Fees:

- Tuition fees: ± EUR 7 600 pa
- Application fee: 85 PLN

Poznan University of Medical Sciences (PUMS), Poznan - one of the best known internationally and largest medical universities in Poland; 1000+ international students; over 95 years of academic experience. English medical programs have been offered for over 28 years (first in Poland to offer medical education in English); significant medical simulation facilities; Irish graduates practicing in Ireland; strong US and Canadian alumni network and experience in preparing for USMLE.

6-year MD

Basic entry requirements and documents:

- Satisfactory grades in biology, chemistry and physics or mathematics (min. 2 subjects, incl. biology) from previous education (secondary school, college or university) (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- Online entrance examination and interview in biology, chemistry and physics

Fees:

- PUMS Application Processing Fee - 85 ZL (±20 EUR)

Advanced MD - this programme has unfortunately been discontinued, however, it is possible to shorten the time of study from the original 6 years to around 5 years due course exemptions and individual organisation of studies (for graduates of undergraduate/graduate programmes in sciences or related to medicine.

- Online entrance examination and interview in biology, chemistry and physics

- PUMS Application Processing Fee - 85 ZL (±20 EUR)
- Interview University Fee: 600 ZL (±150 EUR)
- Tuition fee: Medicine: 64 720 ZL (±14 400 EUR per year, payable in 3 instalments)

- Satisfactory grades in biology, chemistry or physics from previous education (secondary school, college or university) (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- Interview in biology

- Interview in biology and chemistry

- PUMS Application Processing Fee - 85 ZL (±20 EUR)
- Interview University Fee: 600 ZL (±150 EUR)
- Tuition fee: Medicine: 38 700 ZL (±8 600 EUR per year, payable in 3 instalments)



Medical University of Białystok, Białystok - prestigious, fast developing and student friendly university with strong research focus (including use of technology and Artificial Intelligence in medicine) with 2 teaching hospitals and 8 research facilities such as Clinical Research Center, Experimental Medicine Center, Innovation Research Center or Medical Simulation Center. Białystok is located 2-hour drive from Warsaw.

There are around 20 Irish students studying in Białystok now. There is a large number of students from Scandinavia, Pakistan, India and Africa. There are 400 English Division students from over 30 countries.

6-year MD

Basic entry requirements:

- Two out of 4: biology, chemistry, physics, mathematics at the Leaving Certificate (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- Online interview (motivation and attitude, questions primarily in biology, and other science)

Fees:

- Admission University Fee payable after Qualification Board candidate's application approval and before the interview: 500 EUR
- Pre-course Fee: 450 EUR / 350 EUR - if the course is conducted online; (obligatory, 1st year only) biology, chemistry, physics and Polish
- Tuition fees: ±11 000 EUR per year

- Two out of: biology, chemistry, physics, mathematics at the Leaving Certificate (only one at higher level)
(when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- In the absence of one of the sciences, BMAT score can be taken as the result of the science at advanced/higher level

Dentistry (DMD)

Basic entry requirements:

- Admission process is based on Leaving Cert results/predicted grades contest i.e. ranking list
- Two out of: biology, chemistry, physics, mathematics at the Leaving Certificate (only one at higher level)
(when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- In the absence of one of the sciences, BMAT score can be taken as the result of the science at advanced/higher level

Fees:

- Admission University Fee – 85 EUR
- Pre-Course Fee – 600 EUR (obligatory for accepted candidates only)
- Tuition fees: 12 000 EUR pa

Wroclaw Medical University, Wroclaw - less than 2-hour flight to Ireland; 6000 students; 900 international students; its Clinical Hospital is the biggest multi-specialized medical facility in that part of Poland; uni also uses Centre for Pediatric Oncology “Cape of Hope” where youngest oncology and haematology are treated - in the first year operation the doctors at “Cape of Hope” performed the most children bone-marrow transplants in Europe.

6-year MD

Basic entry requirements:

- Admission process is based on Leaving Cert results/predicted grades contest i.e. ranking list
- Biology and chemistry + physics or mathematics at the Leaving Certificate (Higher)
(when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)

Fees:

- Admission University Fee – 85 ZŁ - approx. 20 EUR
- Tuition fees: approx. 11 120 EUR pa

Dentistry (DMD)

Basic entry requirements:

- Admission process is based on Leaving Cert results/predicted grades contest i.e. ranking list
- Biology and chemistry + physics or mathematics at the Leaving Certificate (Higher)
(when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)

Fees:

- Admission University Fee – 85 ZŁ - approx. 20 EUR
- Tuition fees: approx. 13 120 EUR pa

Medical University of Gdańsk is a world-wide recognized university, highly rated by national and international institutions that evaluate universities: (MUG was recorded in CWTS Leiden Ranking 2020 and the U.S. News 2019 ranking – Best Global Universities Rankings). In 2020 the MUG was included in the Shanghai Ranking in the category of medical sciences, in the field of clinical medicine. According to the *Perspektywy magazine* ranking in 2020 it is the best medical university in Poland. Gdańsk is also one of the most international cities in Poland, with thousands of foreign students.

6-year MD

- Two subjects on the High School Diploma: Biology (obligatory) + Chemistry/Physics/Mathematics. Both on an advanced level; (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- Entrance examination consists of a written exam (biology and chemistry) and an interview

Fees:

- Orientation Week fee - 3000 PLN (approx. 670 EUR)
- Tuition fees: 44 000 PLN (approx. 10 000 EUR) pa (fees given for 2021)

Basic entry requirements:

- Two subjects on the High School Diploma: Biology + Chemistry/Physics/Mathematics and English; (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- Interview in motivation and science knowledge

Fees:

- Orientation Week fee - 3000 PLN (approx. 670 EUR)
- Tuition fees: 23 000 PLN (approx. 5 200 EUR) pa (fees given for 2021)

Basic entry requirements:

- Two subjects on the High School Diploma: Chemistry (obligatory) + Biology/Physics/Mathematics. Both on an advanced level; (when applying before sitting the Leaving Certificate: mocks results/predicted grades letter)
- Entrance examination consists of a written exam (biology and chemistry) and an interview

Fees:

- Orientation Week fee - 3000 PLN (approx. 670 EUR)
- Tuition fees: 35 000 PLN (approx. 8 200 EUR) pa (fees given for 2021)

WROCLAW UNIVERSITY

Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences (WUELS) – its Veterinary programme (Master's, 11 semesters) is recognized as the best in Poland (by Perspektywy ranking); awarded international [EAEVE certification](#) for 10 years (2016); located in the centre of Wrocław city it has a great access to hundreds of animals in the onsite clinic and associated farms; walking distance from the largest zoo in Central Europe; guarantees a small group size and a great access to practitioners-lecturers.

Basic admission requirements:

- at least one of two subjects (biology, chemistry) at the Leaving Cert/A-Levels (higher)
- in the absence of either biology or chemistry the university conducts a more in-depth interview in the field of the missing science
- online interview (general motivation & aptitude, biology, chemistry)

Fees:

- University Admission Fee – 19 EUR
- Tuition fee – approx. 8000 EUR pa



Warsaw University of Life Sciences (SGGW) has the highest number of Irish vet students in Poland EAVE [conditional accreditation](#)

Basic admission requirements: 120-minute test in biology and chemistry (MCQ, 40 questions)

Fees:

- External Recruitment Agent Fee (IMS) - 150 EUR (TBC)
- Tuition fee – 4800€ for winter semester
3600€ for summer semester

Other universities: Lublin University of Life Sciences

Accommodation

As recommended, most of Medical Poland's students choose to stay in on-campus student accommodation for at least the first year. This helps get to know other students from year 1 and consecutive years, exchange information and minimise the number of things to take care of outside academic life. All recommended universities offer that kind of student accommodation with 24-hour reception and access systems in the dorms for between 140 and 230 EUR pcm (depending on university and dorm).



Scholarships

Whilst most of Medical Poland's applicants to date do not qualify for [NAWA](http://NAWA.gov.pl)'s support, there are numerous scholarship programmes available for international students via NAWA.gov.pl (note that eligibility varies depending on personal circumstances.)

Living Expenses

Living as a student is prominently more affordable in Poland than in most European Union countries. Monthly average expenses fluctuate between 330 – 430 EUR including dormitory rent, food, transportation etc. Here is a chart with some price examples.

Even though universities charge tuition fees for programmes taught in English, the living expenses offset those fees.

Qualification Recognition

Poland as a member of the European Union shall remain in full force and effect of the Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the European Council of 7 September 2005 on the recognition of professional qualifications. All Polish universities offer curriculum compatible with EU directives including the ECTS system.

Preparatory programmes

Medical Poland Education offers learning and revision support tools for applicants and accepted students conducted on the **Pearson Platform**. All our online programmes are created by the Education Academic Team including lecturers from the best medical and veterinary Polish universities.
